Fur seals are any of nine species of pinnipeds belonging to the subfamily Arctocephalinae in the family Otariidae.They are much more closely related to sea lions than true seals, and share with them external ears (), relatively long and muscular foreflippers, and the ability to walk on all fours.They are marked by their dense underfur, which made them a long-time object of commercial hunting.

The northern, or Steller, sea lion (*Eumetopias jubatus*) is a pale- to golden-brown sea lion of the Bering Sea and both sides of the North Pacific Ocean.It is the largest member of the eared seals. Males are about 3.3 metres in length and weigh 1,000 kg, while females measure about 2.5 metres and weigh less than 300 kg.

California sea lions are "eared seals" native to the West Coast of North America. They live in coastal waters and on beaches, docks, buoys, and jetties. They are easily trained and intelligent and are commonly seen in zoos and aquariums. California sea lions are playful, intelligent, and very vocal (sounding like barking dogs).

Sea lions are covered with coarse guard hairs, while fur seals have a thick underfur, which has historically made them the objects of commercial exploitation. Male otariids range in size from the 70-kg (150-lb) Galápagos fur seal , smallest of all pinnipeds, to the over 1,000-kg (2,200-lb) Steller sea lion .

Seals are found along most coasts and cold waters, but a majority of them live in the Arctic and Antarctic waters. Harbor, ringed, ribbon, spotted and bearded seals, as well as northern fur seals and Steller sea lions live in the Arctic region.

Sea lions are members of the seal or pinniped family. The word pinniped means "flipper feet" or "feather feet" and includes three types of semi-aquatic marine mammals. The walrus, the "true seals" and the "eared seals" or "walking seals". There are 7 species of sea lions, and 9 species of fur seals that make up the "eared seals".

Seals are semiaquatic marine mammals. They have four flippers, so are in a category of animals known as pinnipedia which means 'fin-footed'.. The pinnipeds group contains 3 families: phocidae, the earless or true seal (eg. common seal), otariidae, eared seals (eg. fur seals and sea lions) and odobenidae (walrus).. Seals are believed to have evolved from land based, bear or otter-like ancestors.

Gray seals have relatively short front flippers with five prominent claws. They can curl these flippers to tear food or grasp terrain. Compared with sea lions, seals generally have bulkier torsos, partially due to their method of swimming propulsion. Seals use their rear flippers and move the back half of their bodies in a sculling motion.

Unlike seals, sea lions primarily use their fore-flippers to propel themselves through the water. They also have visible ear-flaps, while seals only have ear holes. California sea lions may struggle with a tendency to overheat. To cool off, they will rest with a flipper in the water, flip sand over their backs or fan their flippers in the water.
